

# CHILD CARE HOME - Annual Training - PRIMARY CAREGIVER

The State of TEXAS requires primary caregivers to obtain at least **30 clock-hours** of training each year. These include:

- 1.) 80% (24 Hours) **MAY** be obtained from self-instructional sources (such as online training available [HERE](#) through Impact Training Center).
- 2.) 20% (6 hours) **MUST** be obtained from interactive sources (ie. Face to face class, webinar, or similiar)

**PLEASE NOTE:** The above annual training clock hours **DO NOT INCLUDE** any requirements for: orientation, pre-service training, CPR and first aid training, transportation safety training, and high school
